## Story

**Read:** John 13:1-17

## Discussion

A question for grownups to ask the children

*Why do you think Jesus washed his disciples' feet?*

Washing feet was not an unusual thing in Jesus time- because the ground was dusty, and most people wore sandals. When you had a guest in your house you might offer to wash their feet. Jesus wanted to teach his disciples a lesson - to help them understand what it means to love and serve others. Jesus lived his life as an example for us to follow of how to share God's love with each other.

A question for children to ask a grownup

*Can you think of a time when somebody did something for you that you were not expecting that blessed or encouraged you?*

## Activities

- 1.** You will need: A bowl of warm water, towels and soap.  
Take some time to wash each other's feet. While you are doing it share with one another some things that you love most about the person who is having their feet washed.
- 2.** Jesus told his disciples to follow his example. To love each other in the same way that he has loved them. Play a game of 'follow the leader' taking it in turn to be the leader and having everybody else to copy you.
- 3.** As a fun creative project, get out some paints and big paper. Make an artwork using all your family's footprints - in whatever design you like!
